- The membership in our Association is voluntary and total number of dentists is 1565.

- In Georgia there are 11 Dental faculties, four of them are State faculties and seven of them are private. All of them provide dental education.

- Undergraduate education in Georgia is five years. Since February 7, 2014 we have four dental specialties:
 - Therapeutic Stomatology
 - Prosthodontists
 - Orthodontists
 - Maxilla-Facial Surgeon.

- The postgraduate education has two directions: first is Residency, which is mandatory for all graduated for dental practice and the second is CDE, which is voluntary.
